I have been asked to review information regarding the above-referenced matter which was presented to the Polk County Board of Commissioners on July 28, 2020. I understand that this matter involves a Petition for Improvement filed with the Red Lake Watershed District (RLWD), and the issue is what, if any, jurisdiction over the matter is retained by Polk County.

I understand that Polk County Ditch No. 39 is encompassed entirely within the boundaries of the RLWD. Further, I noted that this is a Petition for Improvement as opposed to one for repair or maintenance. In light of these facts, Minn. Stat. § 103D.625, subd. 4, mandates that the Petition be filed with the RLWD, and the jurisdiction over this improvement action lay only with the RLWD. This authority includes the review, notice, and hearing requirements for implementation of the improvements. Anyone aggrieved by a decision of the RLWD regarding this Petition has the ability to appeal the matter to district court. It is not a matter within the jurisdiction of the Polk County Board of Commissioners.
