
CLEAN TRUCK KIT LIST

TAKE THESE SIMPLE STEPS NOW TO MINIMIZE THE IMPACT COVID-19 HAS ON YOUR FARM AND MINIMIZE YOUR RISK TO FAMILY AND FRIENDS.



REMEMBER TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT ALL HIGH-TOUCH SURFACES AT THE BEGINNING AND END OF EVERY SHIFT AND WHEN CHANGING DRIVER/OPERATOR.

1 WIPE DOWN SURFACES




Using disposable gloves and soap & water (or a vehicle specific cleaner), wipe down frequently touched surfaces and all surfaces that might have been touched when entering or exiting the vehicle. Ex: doors, handles inside and out, shifter, all window and control buttons, wiper and turn signals, grab handles, seat adjusters, seat belt buckles, seats, steering wheel, mirrors, control knobs & switches, etc.

2 DISINFECT



Disinfect same locations with EPA-registered disinfectant such as Lysol Wipes, diluted bleach solution or an alcohol-based product with at least 70% alcohol. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for all cleaning and disinfection products.

3 KEEP RIG STOCKED



Keep tissues, disposable gloves, and alcohol based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol in your vehicle. Have a small trash can to dispose of tissues and other trash.

CLEANING: the removal of germs, dirt, and impurities from surfaces. It does not kill germs, but by removing them, it lowers their numbers and the risk of spreading infection.

vs.

DISINFECTING: the use of chemicals to kill germs on surfaces. It does not necessarily clean dirty surfaces or remove germs, but by killing germs on a surface *after* cleaning, it can further lower the risk of spreading infection.
