File reviews indicate that local zoning authorities (township and/or city) have been notified ("Notice of Construction or Expansion") at a minimum of 30 days prior to construction or expansion of new or existing feedlots with a capacity less than 300 AU.
File reviews indicate that permits have been issued after the appropriate number (20) of business days following public notifications
File reviews indicate that the county uses an agency approved concrete pit construction checklist and the plans and specifications are complete.
Location restrictions include:
a.No new feedlots in shoreland, floodplain, 300 feet of sinkhole, 100 feet of a private well or 1,000 feet from community well water supply
b.No expansion of an existing feedlot located in a floodplain
File reviews indicate that the county issues interim permits in appropriate situations.
File reviews indicate that the county conducts an inspection prior to permit issuance

- Registration log (log must contain notation that producer was verbally notified of registration/re-registration). The information stored within this log will not be copied and distributed to the landowner, instead the CFO will inform verbally of the information.
- Registration receipt letter with Inspection Report copy will be made if the landowner comes in for an office visit, otherwise a copy will be mailed to the landowner.
- Complete the re-registration process by contacting registered feedlot operators through mailings, newspaper articles, phone calls or office visit that were not completed in 2006.
- There will be direct contact, with follow-up letter, with those who have not updated their re-registration. This action will be completed by March 1, 2010.
- Once feedlot operators have completed re-registration form, CFO's have conducted an inspection at the facility, determine which are feedlot operations and pasture operations, compliance status and complete the manure land application inspection.
- Once inspections has been conducted, send out an follow-up letter in regards to both the feedlot and land application inspection with a copy of the completed inspection forms and also include information on manure management techniques, Operation and Management on operations 300 animal units or less, Operation and Management on operations 300-999 animal units, Pasture Operations and Minnesota Feedlot Rules, Technical Guide for Stockpiling Manure and State Requirements on Land Application of Manure.
