

FOSSTON RECYCLE CENTER

Materials Accepted:

Household Garbage: Can be placed in the compactor located outside the fenced area 24 hrs/day, 7 days/week.

Single Stream (Mixed) Recyclables: Can be placed in blue roll-off recycling containers located outside the fenced area 24 hrs/day, 7 days/week.

Cardboard: Breakdown/flattened. Can be placed in the cardboard container near the compactor. If full, it can be placed in the blue roll-off recycling containers.

Tires: Can be accepted during posted operational hours. Drop-off area is located inside the fenced area. At no charge we will accept passenger vehicle tires, up to 8/mo with a max of 24/yr from Polk County residents. Businesses (including tire sales, vehicle sales, equipment sales, auto service businesses and salvage yards) and non-Polk County residents are NOT accepted at no charge. Tires over passenger vehicle size are accepted for a fee based upon size.

Scrap Metal: Can be accepted during posted operational hours. Drop-off area is located inside the fenced area.

Household Hazardous Waste: Can be accepted during posted operational hours. Drop-off area is located inside the fenced area. Accepted items include: paint, stains, sealants, auto chemicals, lawn/garden chemicals and cleaning supplies from Polk County residents only. Business chemicals are required by law to be handled separately.

Appliances: Can accept residential appliances from Polk County residents at no charge during posted operational hours. Drop-off area for appliances is located inside the fenced area. Business and non-Polk appliances will be accepted for a charge.

TV/Electronics: Can accept residential electronics from Polk County residents at no charge during posted operational hours. Drop-off area for electronics is located inside the fenced area. Business and non-Polk residential electronics accepted will be accepted for a charge.

Fluorescent Bulbs/Ballasts: Can accept residential bulbs/ballasts from Polk County residents at no charge during operational hours. Drop-off area for these items is located inside the fenced area. Business and non-Polk residential bulb/ballasts will be accepted for a charge.

Used Oil/Filters: Can accept residential used oil and oil filters from Polk County residents at no charge during operational hours. Drop-off area for these items is located inside the fenced area. Business and non-Polk residential oil/filters will be accepted for a charge.
