

Polk County E-911 Rural Addressing


Polk County addressing grid originates from the four-county, four-quadrant grid system. Avenues run North/South and use the suffix (Ave) while Streets run West/East and use the suffix (St). Even addresses are on the North and East sides of roads with odd addresses being on the South and West sides of roads. There are potentially 1,000 addresses per mile with 500 on each side of road.

The North/South numeric grid starts at Center Ave S and increases to 500th Ave to the West and increases to 430th Ave to the East. Addresses begin at 10,000 and increase to the North and to the South from Center St W. The addresses include a post directional determining which quad they reside in.

The West/East numeric grid starts at Center St W and increases to 205th St to the North and increases to 450th St to the South. Addresses begin at 10,000 and increase to the West and to the East from Center Ave S. The addresses include a post directional determining which quad they reside in.

US and State Highways retain their names and were given a post directional based on the quad that they reside in. (Ex. US Highway 2 SE) Cities are not affected by the E-911 addressing system.

Roads that were previously named before the E-911 project and that do not fall within the grid system will continue to use that same name.
