BYPASS

Carpet
(unless it is cut into 4'x4' or
smaller pieces)

VCR's /DVD players
Stereos
Small appliances
(Toasters, coffee pots, etc.)
Light fixtures (no bulbs or ballasts)
Humidifiers
Water softeners
Computer Equipment (not the monitor)
Treated wood

METALS

Steel siding/banding
Motors
Bikes
Duct/vents

Any item that is 90% metal is acceptable
at no charge in the metal bin
